4-H camp is a fun and exciting way for youth ages 9 to 18 to spend a week away from home. Campers are 9-12, CIT's are 13 and up (more information inside brochure) and Counselors are anyone who has completed CIT training through age 18.

The camping program helps youth learn new skills, build self-esteem, and challenges them to be innovative and creative. 4-H Camp is accredited through the American Camping Association and focuses on the 4-H Philosophy of "Learning by Doing."

### Scholarships

Financial assistance is available. Please contact the Spotsylvania County Extension Office to request a scholarship application. A \$50.00 non-refundable and non-transferable deposit is required to guarantee your camper's slot, regardless of scholarship requests. Please have your \$50.00 deposit available when turning in your registration and scholarship

### Refund and cancellation policies



Before May 1, 2020, you are eligible for a 50% refund. Refunds of remaining balance will be given **only** in the event of serious circumstances. All refund requests must be submitted **in writing** to the Extension office no later than May 15, 2020. After May 16, 2020—**NO Refund and NO Transferring.**

### Counselor in Training Program (CIT)

If you are at least 13 years of age and will complete 7th grade this school year, you are eligible to become a Counselor in Training. If you have a desire to be a CIT please contact the office and the appropriate application will be mailed to you. **Participation in training sessions is required before camp.**

Training dates will be provided at a later date.

### Camp Class Sign Up

**Classes are assigned on a first come first serve basis.** You will not be able to sign your child up for classes until all paperwork is completed, turned in, and paid in full. Class signups will be sent out at a later date.
