## **Job Description**

The Virginia Cooperative Extension Family Nutrition Program Assistant (Adult) assists caregivers of young children and other limited-resource participants who meet federal eligibility guidelines to eat healthier meals and snacks and obtain the best nutrition at the lowest food cost. In collaboration with many organizations, the Virginia Family Nutrition Program aims to help reduce the risk of nutrition insecurity by working with families to gain practical skills that result in changed behaviors to shop smart, eat smart, and move more.

The individual in this position will recruit, enroll, and teach adult participants individually or in group settings (in-person, by phone, or using video-conferencing) about basic principles of food resource management, food preparation, nutrition, and physical activity. This position involved collaborating with local agencies and organizations that work with limited-resource families, marketing the program, and collecting evaluation records for all programs.

The Family Nutrition Program Assistant (Adult) is an employee and representative of Virginia Cooperative Extension and works under the supervision of an Area Coordinator. The person in this position is expected to travel to provide in-person programs and build community partnerships. Renewal of the position is contingent on the availability of funds.

- Experience communicating information, skills, or teaching others
- Experience working directly with people from diverse racial, ethnic, cultural,

and socio-economic backgrounds, especially individuals living in poverty or with limited resources

- Evidence of being a self-starter, with drive and initiative.
- Ability to assume responsibility and work independently in an organized manner, without close supervision. Document efforts and seek guidance as needed.
- Experience maintaining accurate, legible records.

- Experience working with: community resources of the position and potential clients; or knowledge of the community and social service programs for limited-resource families.
- Personal or work-related experience with federal nutrition assistance programs (WIC, SNAP, Commodity Foods, National School Breakfast, and Lunch Programs).
